- 4. What level would you consider The Ridge to be at when looking at the 5 Levels of churches? What would it take for The Ridge to reach the next level?
- 5. Respond to this question, "Am I trying to be the hero, or am I trying to make heroes out of others?" Dig beneath the layer of your response. Why do you think that is?
- 6. Which of the 5 essentials practices of a Hero Maker is a strength of yours? Which is a challenge? Why do you think that is?
- 7. What are 1 to 2 things you need to START doing to develop more leaders?
- 8. What are 1 to 2 things you need to STOP doing to develop more leaders?
- 9. What accountability question would you like for me to ask you next time we meet?
