Meanwhile, I thought I should send Epaphroditus back to you. He is a true brother, coworker, and fellow soldier. And he was your messenger to help me in my need. But God had mercy on him—and also on me, so that I would not have one sorrow after another.

For he risked his life for the work of Christ, and he was at the point of death while doing for me what you couldn't do from far away.
