

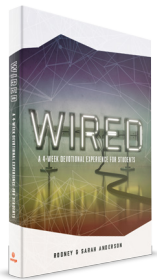

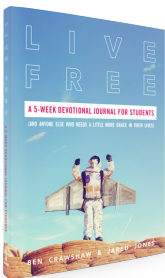

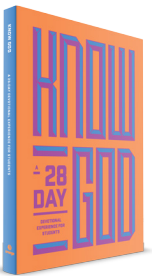
Wired
